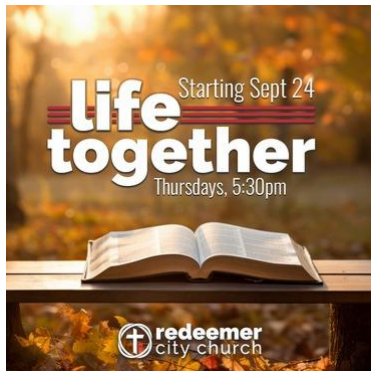

LIFE TOGETHER KIDS PROGRAM

This fall, Redeemer Kids is diving into the book of Proverbs as we learn what it means to live with godly wisdom! Each week, kids will explore practical biblical wisdom for everyday life, including our work, generosity, words, and relationships. Lessons will cover the same themes for both JK–Grade 2 and Grades 3–5, with teaching and activities tailored to each age group. We will also have a fun time of games and activities!

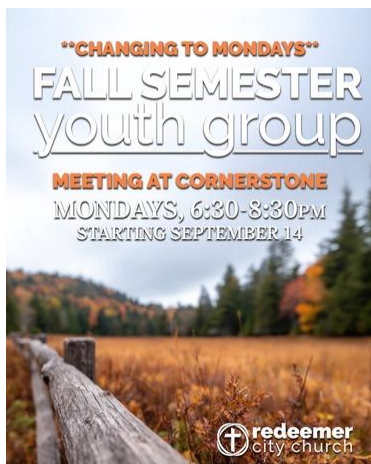

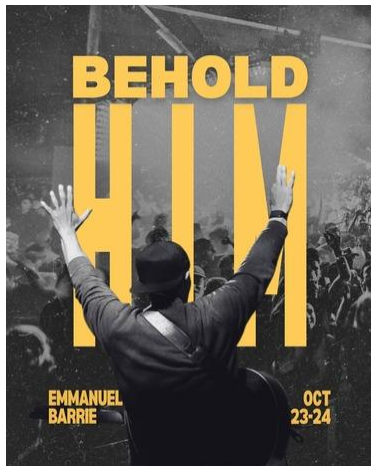
